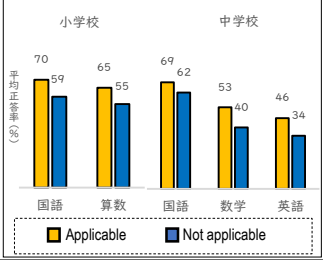
Schools, families, and communities who wish for the growth of children should share their thoughts and wishes, connect with each other, and utilize their respective strengths to interact with children.

There is a tendency for students who answered "applicable" to the question "I am applying what I learned in other studies" to have a higher average correct answer rate in surveys related to their subjects.

Based on the creation of classes and schools where children can learn with peace of mind, we encourage children to think independently, communicate with each other, expand and deepen their ideas. Let's devise ways of "learning tasks" and "questioning, coordination, and support (questioning, etc.)" so that students can learn from each other.

During life studies and comprehensive study time, students develop the qualities and abilities needed to think about their own way of life. It is important to create opportunities to utilize what has been learned in subjects, mainly during comprehensive study time, and to enrich the learning process while effectively utilizing people, things, and things in the local community.

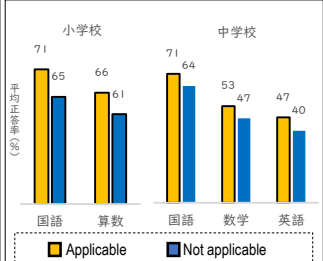

Students who answered "Yes" to the question "I make my own plans and study at home" tended to have a higher average correct answer rate in surveys regarding their subjects.

It is important to acknowledge, praise, and encourage children's efforts so that they value the process of learning, not just the results. Thinking about study plans and reading together can also help children expand and deepen their learning.

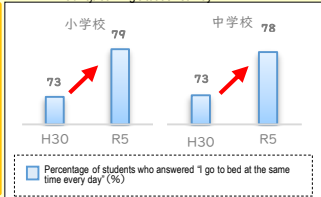
